

### Rotary International Scholarships

Rotary International is receiving applications for Rotary International Scholarships for study abroad during the Academic Year beginning September 1989. The Rotary Scholarship covers complete cost for an American student for one year in a college or university abroad, in any country in which there are Rotary clubs. (Members Rotary families are not eligible.)

**There are several types of Scholarships:**

- Graduate or Undergraduate scholarships**, in practically any field of study.
- Vocational scholarships**, for persons with a secondary degree, with at least two years' of experience.
- Teachers of the handicapped**, with two years' experience
- Journalism scholarships**, with two years' experience.

**Eligibility Requirements for the Scholarship**

1. The applicant must be enrolled as a fulltime undergraduate student on the College campus.
2. By the end of the current semester, the student must have completed a minimum of 12 credit hours in German at the undergraduate level.
3. The student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00.

The student must be planning to pursue academic study in the Federal Republic of Germany prior to undergraduate graduation.

**Selection Criteria for the Scholarship**

1. *The student's academic record overall, and in German, specifically.*
2. *The student's total number of credit hours in German.*
3. *The student's extracurricular activities, including athletics, with special weight given to those activities related to German.*
