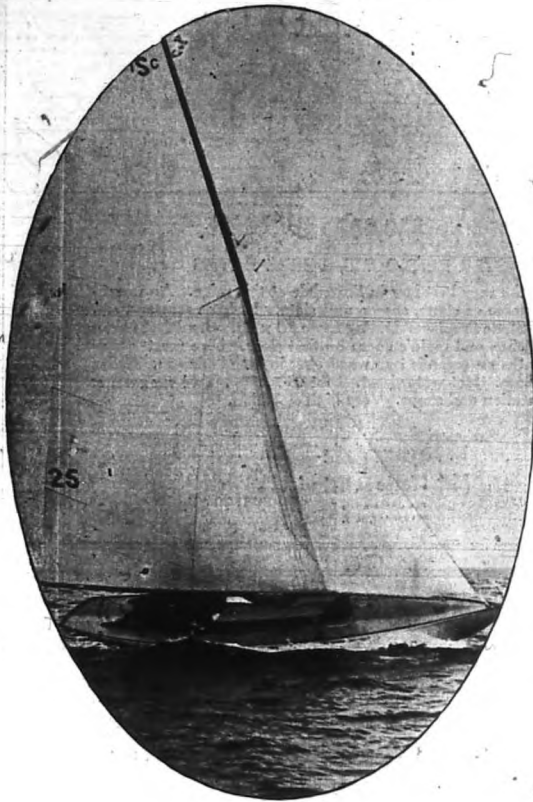


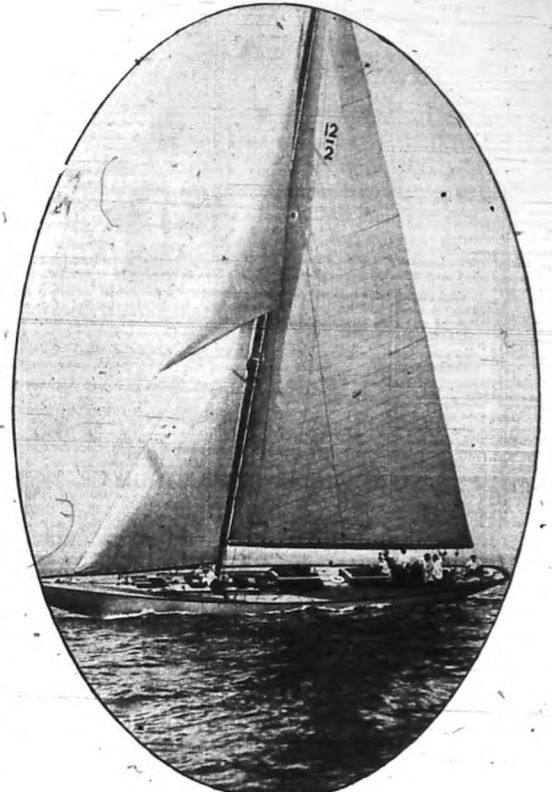
Club Held Its Annual Flag Raising Ceremonies Last Saturday Afternoon
