Construction of Playland Casino to Be Built at Cost of \$500,000 Well Under Way

DR. WARNER WILL REMAIN IN FAR WEST

Word has been received here of the arrival in Los Angeles, Calif. of Dr. Franklin H. Warner, 30 Ridgeview avenue, the city, associate moderator of the National Council of the Congregational churches. Largest Individual Project in \$6,000,000 County Recreation Center on Sound—Year-Around Resort to Be Ready Next Summer.

As an expenditure of \$500,000 the Westchester County Park Commission now has well under way the construction work on the largest single project of the \$6,000,000 county recreation center, the Playland Casino, for which ground was broken on October 1. It is expected to be completed by the end of next summer and for the first time in its history Westchester will have an all-year-around recreational center in which practically every amusement and facility for entertainment in the winter will be provided.

The Casino will operate throughout the entire year. The remainder of Playland has heretofore closed shortly after Labor Day because of weather conditions. The casino is expected to make the county park attractive and remunerative throughout the entire year and provide work for the skeleton staff which has been found essential to retain during the months the park has been closed.

The Casino is designed to be the largest and most complete of its kind in the eastern states. The plans of the Building and other county organizations will be completed by the end of next summer and for the first time in its history Westchester will have an all-year-around recreational center in which practically every amusement and facility for entertainment in the winter will be provided.

For two years engineers and architects have been preparing plans for this gigantic amusement building and on September 15, contracts for the construction were let to Johnson & Miller, Inc., contractors, of Yonkers.
