The Lincoln Agricultural School has just purchased the Leonard Austin farm, containing 80 acres, at Somers Center. Negotiations have been carried on for some time past by the authorities of the Institution with a view to purchasing the already large tract of land owned by them at Somers. The price paid for the farm was \$9,500.

July will see in operation an automobile mail and stage coach running between Armonk and Valhalla station. At present the horse stage makes two trips daily, but with the installation of the new vehicle a schedule of four round trips will be made. The motor stage will carry more than a dozen passengers and have plenty of room for express and the freight packages. Armonk, situated six miles from the railroad, will easily be brought within commuting distance.

Attorney-General Wickersham, by his special Deputy Attorney-General, Hugh Gordon Miller, moved before the Supreme Court, in Washington, D. C., for leave to file a petition for an injunction to restrain the Bronx Valley Sewer Commissioners from constructing a trunk sewer discharging its contents into the Hudson River, below Yonkers. The motion was granted.

This action of the Department of Justice is in response to the petition signed by representatives of the Chamber of Commerce, the Produce Exchange and the Merchants' Association of New York City, recently forwarded by Edward Hatch, Jr., to the Attorney-General. In which he was requested to proceed against the Bronx Sewer Commissioners in the same manner as against the Passaic Sewer Commissioners last Fall.

Dr. Caroline Rickards, formerly of the Clifton Springs Sanitarium, has leased through Carpenter & Pelton, the Townsend-Mathews place on the summit of Kisco mountain. It will be occupied as a sanitarium for women.

The new management of the Scarsdale Estates report many sales throughout White Plains and Scarsdale. In the last few weeks over \$40,000 worth of property has been sold to investors and home seekers. The most recent sales are seven plots on Woodland Place, to a purchaser whose name is withheld. The sale was made through the agency of Cooley & West.
