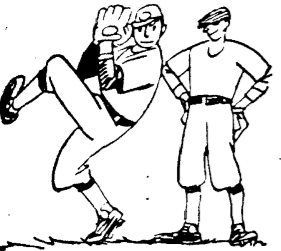


Gossip About Town
