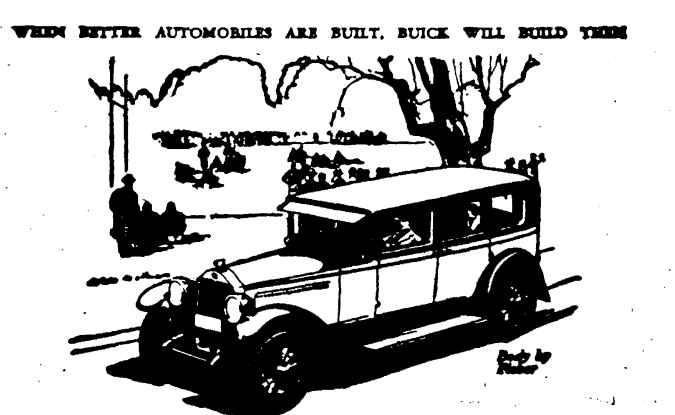
WATSON WEDS MISS LUTHER
