Holiday Party Ham

A beautiful baked ham, thinly sliced, makes wonderful holiday party fare. It is especially festive when it arrives at the table with a golden glaze of maple-blended syrup, decorated with red maraschino cherries and is surrounded with shiny apple slices. To make the apple slices glistening here, combine ¼ cup of maple-blended syrup with a dash of salt and add rather thick slices of three cored but unpeeled apples. Cook apples in the syrup, covered, about 5 minutes... then uncover and cook until tender and transparent. These are delicious hot or cold.

Glazed Holiday Ham

1/2 cup butter or margarine	1/2 cup (about) red maraschino cherries
1/3 cup Log Cabin Syrup	Few strips of citron or orange peel
1/4 cup orange (or pineapple) juice	Water cross

Melt shortening. Add maple-blended syrup and juice; blend. Bake ham in slow oven (225° F.) until done, basting with syrup and juice mixture frequently during last hour of baking time. With maraschino cherries, make a holiday wreath; a bow of citron or orange peel. Serve with glazed apples and sprigs of water cross.
