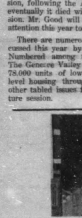
Mr. Ronald J. Good, 18th District County Legislator, will again raise the Prison Reform Bill before the '73 Legislature.

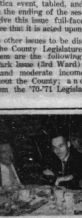
There are numerous other issues to be discussed this year by the County Legislature. Numerous among them are the following:
