Tallahassee, Fla. - The Department of Business and Commerce of Florida A&M University has received a \$25,000 grant from the General Electric Foundation to underwrite a new faculty position for the department of business administration.

Women who get smaller and narrower (constrict), and the blood supply from the mother to the baby is seriously reduced, possibly depriving the baby of its required food.

Women with a previous history of high blood pressure should be under the close scrutiny of their doctor during pregnancy. With proper care, in most cases, they can have a normal pregnancy and deliver healthy babies.

Some women with high blood pressure may deliver babies that are thin and scrawny, their weight being about half that of the "low birth weight baby." Statistics show that low birth weight babies have less chance of surviving than normal weight babies.

The chief worry tied in with high blood pressure is toxemia. In this disease, excess fluids begin to be retained in the body. As a result, the blood pressure goes up, the kidneys do not function properly, and the hands, feet or face swell. Since the kidneys do not remove enough waste and fluid material from the blood, the pressure may go up even higher.

Toxemia occurs most often in women who have had high blood pressure or kidney disease, particularly if they are fat, are carrying twins or have diabetes.

But another important class of women can be affected. These are often young women between the age of 15 and 29, who live in poverty areas, whose diets are poor, who are pregnant for the first time and who are worried because of lack of knowledge about their pregnancy or fear that something is wrong with the baby. In such cases, a doctor can tell you how closely this describes may young women in our inner cities and power rural areas.

Such women may not go to a doctor when they first become pregnant and so continue their poor eating habits and become more anemic, thus endangering themselves and their children.

Among the symptoms of toxemia are: above normal weight gains with retention of excess fluids, headaches and pain in the upper abdomen (just below the rib cage), swelling of hands or feet that does not go away, and in severe cases, convulsions.

Although toxemia has been observed by doctors for over 2,000 years, what actually causes it, is still not definitely known. We do know that when women have better diets and exercise and when pregnant women receive medical attention, the severe form of toxemia is rare in the United States.

In announcing the grant, Dr. Donald J. Wason, Secretary of the Foundation, said that the Department of Business and Commerce is providing graduates to fill a critical need in industry and commerce - well trained and qualified, newly trained for the field of business.

How much salt (although some salt is needed at all times). If her symptoms are not relieved by these measures, the woman may be admitted to the hospital so that she can get more complete rest and receive further treatment.

If high blood pressure and other signs of toxemia are present at the time of delivery, special care must be taken for mother and baby for the first three days after delivery. After that time, the mother's body usually begins to expel any excess fluids that have built up during pregnancy and the toxemia usually disappears.

The most important step for every woman who wants to have good health during her pregnancy and wants to protect her baby is to put herself in the care of a doctor and consult him about any problem that comes up.
