garden of race, color, or creed. Added to this, Rep. Herman Badillo, the first Puerto Rican ever elected to Congress, will face New York City Comptroller Abraham D. Besne in a runoff primary June 26. Besne received 34% of the vote while Badillo received 23% of the vote. Only time will reveal who the winner will be.

Today, there are approximately 50 minority mayors in America, including one woman, but most of them were elected on the voting power of the race.

## Two Clergymen Honored

There was one time in Buffalo that two similar events could be presented on the same evening and be very successful.

However, on June 8th, the Prominential Baptist Church honored its pastor, Rev. T. Davis, dean of minority clergymen, at dinner in the Elva Porcupine Supper Club, while Gettysburg Baptist Church honored its pastor, Rev. Herbert V. Reid, on his 10th Anniversary at the St. Anselm Hotel.
