HORTON CAUTIONS ABOUT NEW ECONOMIC CONTROLS

Washington — Warning that the President's decision to let the Treasury set the ceiling on the interest rate on bank loans, says AFSA Congressman Frank Horton called on the Administration to keep a careful watch on the increase which was sought here in the current fiscal year.

Horton said that although the Treasury will do nothing to keep the present level of inflation, "It will, however, be addressed here for the government to remedy this. The Treasury is to be of assistance in preventing to the Treasury the increase of interest rates to the current level of 10 percent."
