

Exceed Expenditures

State Comptroller Arthur Levitt has announced that total expenditures of the 57 New York State counties outside New York City for 1970 exceeded \$2.2 billion, double that of 1965. Increased spending was accompanied by higher revenues and borrowing in 1970. The greatest percentage revenue increase during the five-year span was in sales taxes, while rose from \$27 million to \$264 million.
