Merrills Wed On Homestead

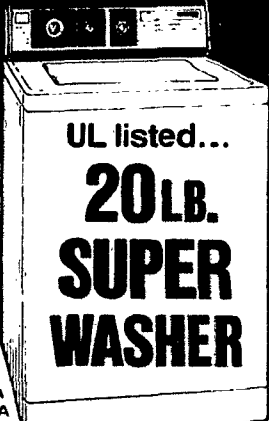
Mr. and Mrs. George R. Merrill were married October 8 at the Merrill Homestead.

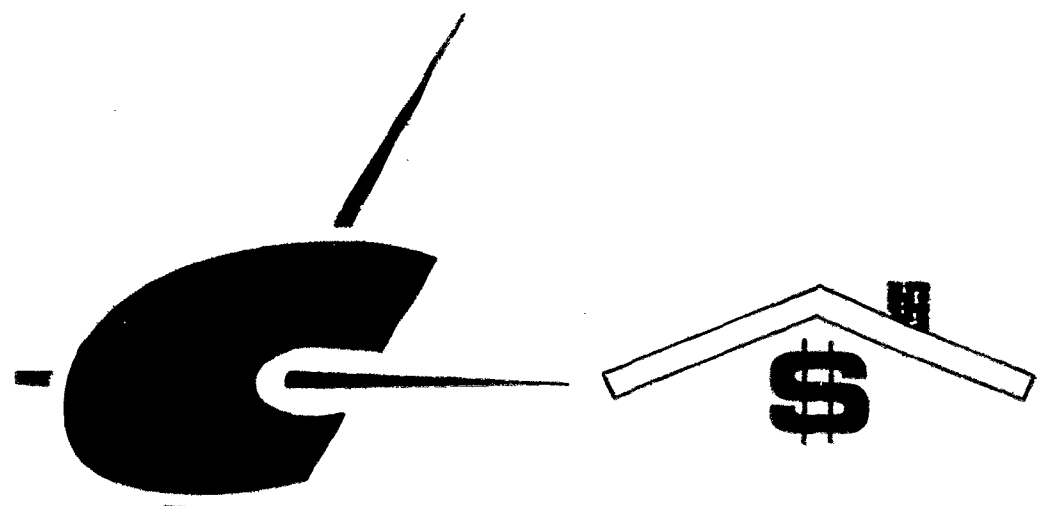
