**RECIPE OF THE WEEK**  
Chocolate Marshmallow Harp-tacks.

1 - 3 oz. package cream cheese  
2 tablespoon milk  
2 cups sifted confectioners sugar  
2-1 oz. squares unsweetened chocolate, melted  
1/4 teaspoon vanilla  
dash of salt  
3 cups miniature marshmallows  
Flaked coconut as desired.

Combine softened cream cheese and milk until well blended. Gradually add sugar, Stir in chocolate and vanilla and salt. Fold in marshmallows. Drop rounded teaspoon of mixture in coconut. Toss until well covered. Place on baking sheet and chill until firm. Makes about four dozen. - Anna Mae Strife
