Mayor Seeks Re-Election

The terms of Mayor Leonard K. Virkler and two village trustees - Dr. John S. Miller and Rodney Persons expire in March. Mr. Persons was appointed Jan. 18 to fill the remainder of the term of the late Louis F. Meda. It is expected Mayor Virkler and Dr. Miller will seek re-election and Mr. Persons will seek a two-year term on the board. Mr. Virkler who will be seeking his fourth two-year term, has served on the board since 1961, first as trustee and then as mayor to succeed Floyd Lomon. Dr. Miller was elected to the board in 1967 and was subsequently reelected for two terms.

Mr. Persons, treasurer of the Lewis County Trust Company in charge of personnel, purchasing, and assistant in operations, is new to the local political scene. Mr. Virkler and Mr. Persons are Republicans. Dr. Miller is a Democrat. Other members of the board are Russell R. Zeller, Republican, and John Fogarty, Democrat.

The village caucus will be Monday evening, Feb. 12, at the Lowville Academy cafeteria.
