**Restrict Seeded Area**

At a recent meeting, representatives of the Lewis County Fair Board and the Lowville Academy and Central School Board agreed to post no trespassing signs on the field in the middle of the Fairgrounds. Snowmobiles, motorcycles, bicycles, and all vehicles are prohibited from the newly seeded area until the turfs had a chance to develop.

This summer and fall a group of volunteers, headed by Dr. John Schlieder and Richard Bush, with cooperation from many others, rebuilt and re-seeded the field so that it would be ready for football and softball games next summer. Much time and money were spent in rebuilding, fertilizing, seeding, and grading the area that is surrounded by the track. Use by snowmobiles or other vehicles would cause damage now since the new grass has not established a good root system. Even when covered with snow, the grass could suffer from oil spills or leaks from the snowmobiles.

**Man Charged**

Charles Malachowski, Penny Settlement Road, Port Leyden, and owner of the Turin Liquor Store at Turin, was arrested by Deputy Thomas Jaconski Nov. 19 on a charge of unlawfully dealing with a child.
