Financial Aid For Vets

Returning veterans who have not completed high school or received an equivalency certificate can earn their diploma and go on to college or higher education institutions, according to Lewis Manfred, state veteran counselor.

They receive financial assistance while completing their high school studies, he said, without any charge to their entitlement to higher education under the GI Bill.

Under the program a single veteran receives \$20 per month while pursuing a full time course of study. Additional financial assistance is provided those with dependents.

In order to qualify for this benefit a veteran must have served on active duty for more than 180 days, any part of which occurred after January 31, 1955 and discharge must have been under honorable conditions.

Those who already have their high school diploma, but need special courses to qualify for admission to an institute of higher learning, are also eligible for this assistance.

Veterans counseling and assistance in applying for veterans benefits is available at the local veterans counseling center of the New York State Division of Veterans Affairs located at the Court House in Lowville.

J. Carnie, 71, Dies

James McGregor Carnie, 71, retired official of Latex Fiber Industries, Inc., died Nov. 21 at 8:45 p.m. in the Lewis County General Hospital, Lowville, where he had been a patient since Nov. 6. He had been ill since August. He was born in Glasgow, Scotland, Oct. 4, 1902, a son of Thomas Gordon and Isabella McGregor Carnie. He attended Pratt Institute, Brooklyn and had worked for the United States Rubber Company, now UniRoyal, Inc., starting in the laboratory in New York City in 1919, and worked in Cleveland, Ohio, and Passaic, N.J. He began employment in 1932 in the saturating department and later became superintendent of this department. Prior to his retirement he was responsible for process and development research. An active and ingenious thinker of new and better methods of manufacturing lexide, he was responsible for several products and process innovations used by the company today. He retired from Latex in Nov. 1967, after 35 years of service.

He married Helen Carrier, Aug. 20, 1940, at Cora, with Rev. William T. Eaton, pastor of the Presbyterian Church, officiating.

He was a member of the Beaver Falls United Methodist Church, the 25-Year Club of Latex Fiber Industries, Carlodwan Country Club, the Beaver Falls Fire Department and the Knickerbocker Lodge, 642, F and A.M.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Helen C. Carnie; three sons, Roderick, Dillon, Colo., Robert, Lowville, David, a student at Marietta College, Ohio, and a brother, Thomas Carnie, New York City.

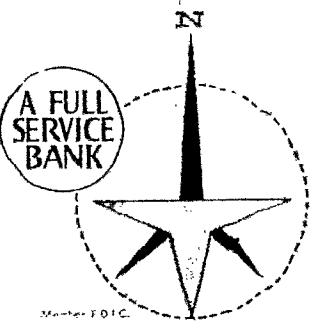
The funeral was Nov. 24 in the Beaver Falls United Methodist Church, Rev. Bruce Chapman, pastor, officiating.

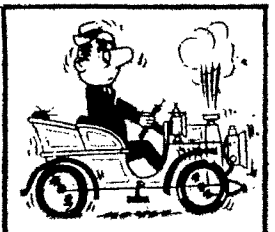
